Canadian Pacific Rail Strike

Dear Valued Customer,

Canadian Pacific Railway (CP) has suspended freight service across Canada due to a strike which began early this morning by the Teamsters Canada Rail Conference union.

All freight moving **in and out of Canadian ports only** will be impacted by delays. Containers currently on the water destined for Canadian ports will be stopped at the port. Containers currently on the rail will stop in-transit and will not continue on to the destination terminal. If the containers have already arrived at the destination terminal, they will not be unloaded from the train until the strike is ended. This will cause delays at all ports as well as at all inland terminals.

We have been advised that Canadian National Railway (CN) is currently operational and freight serviced by CN is moving.

We will keep you updated as the situation progresses. Please contact your OWL customer service representative for specific information on the impact to your shipments.
