## **Nhava Sheva International Container Terminal Strike - October 29th Update**

### **Maher Terminal Delays**

Our contacts advise that the strike is still underway with trucks still waiting outside of locked gates at the Nhava Sheva International Container Terminal - part of the Nhava Sheva port complex near Mumbai, India. Export bookings are not being made at this stage.

DP World Terminal Workers are on strike over a wage dispute with NSICT management. The strike is limited to one terminal at the port and other terminals are still functioning although there is congestion in the area. It could take another week before ongoing negotiations show progress and the situation improves.

Some carriers are discussing the possibility of congestion surcharges although we are waiting for further information before confirming anything.

### **Maher Terminal Delays**

NY/NJ's Maher terminal is congested due to labor shortages and trucking volumes. This has been a tough few months for Maher with the implementation of a new operations management system and now labor shortages, which have slowed considerably the port's ability to function at full capacity.
