Delays Affecting Some Indian Ports

We'd like to bring you an update on info our contacts in India have provided:

Mundra Port

Severe weather, rough seas and strong winds shut the port today, September 27th. All cargo operations have been suspended for 12 hours before being reviewed.

Local roads have also been flooded making transportation to and from the port difficult.

Nhava Sheva

A work stoppage is affecting operations at the JNPT gate. Transport Operators have walked out in protest against working conditions, which has resulted in delays to terminal operations at the gate.

New Delhi Inland Container Depot

Heavy congestion at the depot has necessitated management at the Inland Container Depot to release the notice to cease issuing examination job orders, warehouse carting and LCL carting until the backlog is cleared and the congestion alleviated. Some loading job orders, factory carting and empty container removal permits will continue to be issued to ease the situation.

We are expecting delays into and out of the region although the closure time of local ports due to weather should be made up during ocean transits.
